



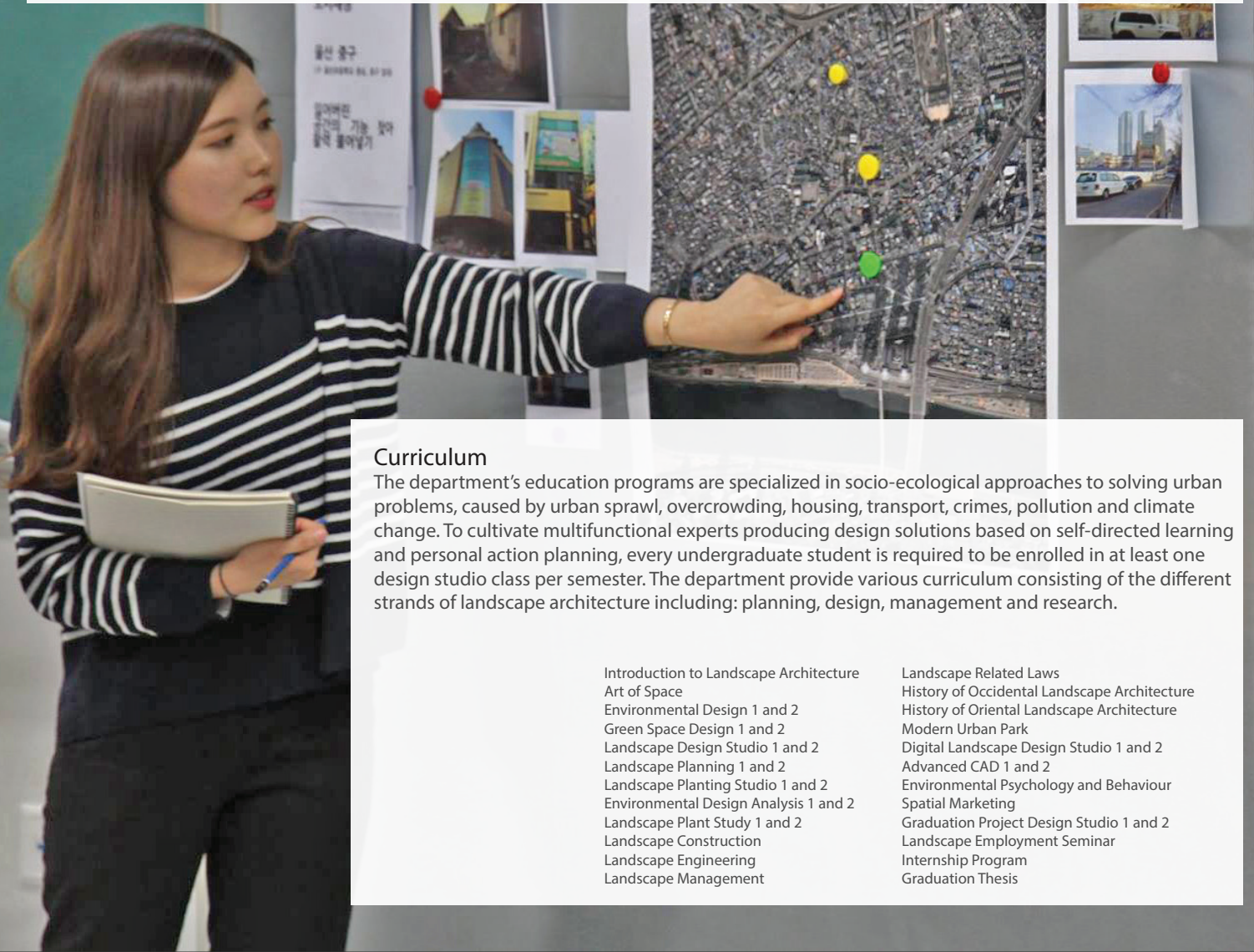

## about dola



Founded in 2010, the Department of Landscape Architecture at Keimyung University is one of the leading department to study landscape architecture in Korea. Well-designed 4-year undergraduate and 2-year postgraduate courses spanning arts, social sciences, geography and ecology provide the theoretical foundation with practical experiences for highly motivated and enthusiastic students in a supportive environment. The department also promotes interdisciplinary researches in landscape architecture that straddles the world of science and art, large scale planning and detailed design. Leading researchers and practitioners who have a range of academic and professional backgrounds supports students to learn in a spectacular, inspirational setting, with brilliant facilities and support. There are 6 academic staffs and over 10 associate tutors who deliver an exceptionally comprehensive and innovative landscape education to approximately 150 undergraduate and 30 postgraduate students. In the education city, Daegu, Keimyung University offers relatively lower tuition fees, living costs and also well-prepared scholarship programs for international students, who are ready to be a creative specialist planning, designing and managing places for people and nature.



## Curriculum

The department's education programs are specialized in socio-ecological approaches to solving urban problems, caused by urban sprawl, overcrowding, housing, transport, crimes, pollution and climate change. To cultivate multifunctional experts producing design solutions based on self-directed learning and personal action planning, every undergraduate student is required to be enrolled in at least one design studio class per semester.
